whose signature appears hereon is hereby permitted subject to the conditions if any, specified hereunder to;-

To the Temporary Closure of footpath, shoulder edge and part of any road or street within the Ipswich City Council local road area for the purposes of undertaking maintenance works on power poles and overhead power lines on behalf of Energy Queensland in the area.

From: Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2024 to Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025 between 7::00 am and 5:00 pm on a local street, between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm on a major arterial road Monday to Friday, between 9:00 am and 2:00 pm within 200 m of a school zone on a school day along with between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm Weekends excluding public holidays ONLY. TRAFFIC DIVERSION CANNOT BE PLACED ON THE ROAD UNTIL THE ABOVE LISTED TIMES AND MUST BE REMOVED BY THE ABOVE LISTED TIMES.

#### **CONDITIONS**;-

- 1. Ensure all residents in street and businesses are advised of the planned disruption to traffic.
- 2. All due consideration shall be given to all residents for access to and from their residential address.
- 3. That the area be barricaded off along with flood lighting and flashing lights to be placed on the barricades during the hours of darkness.
- 4. That warning signs be erected around the area.
- 5. That a safe area be left for pedestrian traffic especially around school times due to the increase of children in the area.
- 6. That the attached road closure notification is to be circulated in the area advertising the upcoming road closure.
- 7. That the traffic be controlled by qualified traffic controllers or a Police Officer on Special Duty.
- 8. All Transport and Main Roads are not covered under this permit and require a separate permit to work on such footpath, shoulder or roadway.
- 9. Any deviation from any of these conditions will cause this permit to become invalid and the work will be ceased immediately until authorisation is given for the work to recommence.
- 10. This permit is for the above mentioned locations only and all other roads are to remain open to traffic at all times.
- 11. This permit can be cancelled at any time if traffic is delayed to delayed periods or any condition is breached.
