

Solar Bonus Scheme Tariff Change

Under the legislation for the Queensland Government Solar Bonus Scheme, a change to the electricity account name may impact eligibility to the Solar Bonus Scheme amount being received and subsequently Energex will change the tariff.

Note: If you rent or sell your premises and the account name is changed, you are no longer eligible for the Solar Bonus Scheme.
