whose signature appears hereon, is hereby permitted, subject to the conditions hereunder to:

**To the Temporary Closure of footpath, shoulder edge and part of any road or street within the Somerset Regional Council locally owned road areas for the purpose of undertaking maintenance works on Energy Queensland electrical infrastructure.**

**As per Somerset approval SRC Ref: 1863977 - Traffic Control Permit for replacing electrical infrastructure**

- Unless otherwise approved in writing by the Director of Operations (Somerset Regional Council), hours of construction shall be:
- Monday to Saturday - 6.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. - Noise permitted
- Sunday and Public Holidays - No audible noise permitted

**Work or business which causes audible noise shall not be conducted from or on the site outside the above hours.**

#### **Project Specific Conditions**

- Where major works (operational projects) are planned by Energex a separate permit is required.
- Any Energex Emergency works will continue to occur as required with advance notification to Council, where possible.
- Energex will endeavour to align capital projects with Somerset Regional Council projects to avoid duplication of effort.
- The applicant is responsible for meeting all conditions from the Department of Transport and Main Road for works adjacent or in a state controlled road.

Permit shall remain in force from 24/06/2026 to 20/05/2027, unless sooner suspended, surrendered or cancelled.

#### **CONDITIONS**

1. Ensure all residents in street and businesses are advised of the planned disruption to traffic.
2. All due consideration shall be given to all residents for access to and from their residential address.
3. That the area be barricaded off along with flood lighting and flashing lights to be placed on the barricades during the hours of darkness.
4. That warning signs be erected around the area.
5. That a safe area be left for pedestrian traffic especially around school times due to the increase of children in the area.
6. That the traffic be controlled by qualified traffic controllers or Police Officer on Special Duty to be organised by Traffic Control company.
7. All Transport Department conditions will be complied with and necessary permits obtained and held at each site.
8. Any deviation from any of these conditions, or the conditions of Somerset Regional Council approval Ref: 1863977 , will cause this permit to become invalid and the work will be ceased immediately until authorisation is given for the work to recommence.
9. This permit is valid for Somerset Regional Council owned roads, all other roads are to remain open at all times.
10. This permit can be cancelled at any time if traffic is delayed for extended periods or if any condition is breached.

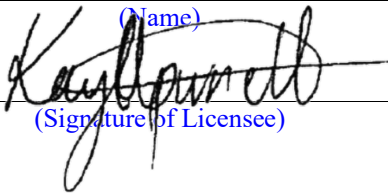
This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.
