RE: Road Authority Approval – Temporary Traffic Management – Energex Blanket Acceptance 2026/2027 Financial Year

Gympie Regional Council (Council), in its capacity as the Road Authority for local government-controlled roads, hereby grants approval for the implementation of temporary traffic management associated with the activity detailed below.

This approval is issued under the authority of:

- Transport Infrastructure Act 1994
- Local Government Act 2009
- Gympie Regional Council Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2011

This approval relates only to Council's consent as Road Authority for the temporary regulation of traffic and/or occupation of the road reserve. It does not constitute approval of the Traffic Control Plan (TCP) design, workplace health and safety arrangements, environmental compliance, noise approvals, or any other legislative requirement that may apply.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

This approval is strictly conditional upon compliance with the following conditions:

1. Compliance with Traffic Management Standards

All temporary traffic management must:

- Be implemented strictly in accordance with the submitted Traffic Guidance Scheme (TGS) referenced above;
- Comply with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD);
- Comply with the Queensland Guide to Temporary Traffic Management (QGTMM);
- Comply with the Australian Guide to Temporary Traffic Management (AGTTM);
- Comply with all applicable Queensland traffic legislation.

Any variation to the approved TGS requires prior written approval from Council.

2. Responsibility for Implementation

The Applicant retains full responsibility for:

- The design, implementation, monitoring and removal of all temporary traffic management measures;
- Ensuring all traffic control devices are installed correctly and maintained in effective working order;
- Ensuring the safety of road users, workers and the public;
- Compliance with all relevant legislation, codes and standards.

Council's approval does not transfer operational responsibility to Council.



3. Traffic Management Personnel

The person in control of traffic management implementation must hold a current Traffic Management Implementation (TMI) qualification.

The organisation implementing the traffic management must be registered under the Queensland Department of Transport and Main Roads Traffic Management Registration Scheme (where required).

4. Public Liability Insurance and Indemnity

The Applicant must maintain Public Liability Insurance for a minimum of \$20,000,000 for the duration of the works.

The Applicant indemnifies and holds harmless Gympie Regional Council against all claims, demands, actions, proceedings, damages, losses, costs and expenses arising out of or in connection with:

- The implementation of temporary traffic management;
- The conduct of the works or event;
- Any act or omission of the Applicant or its contractors.

Evidence of insurance must be provided upon request.

5. Protection of Council Assets

The Applicant is responsible for any damage caused to Council infrastructure or assets. All damage must be repaired to Council's satisfaction at the Applicant's cost.

6. Access Requirements

Continuous and safe access must be maintained for:

- Emergency services;
- Residents and businesses;
- Pedestrians and vulnerable road users.

Where full road closure is proposed, specific written approval must be obtained.

7. Notification Requirements

The Applicant must provide adequate notification to affected residents, businesses, public transport operators and emergency services prior to commencement of works.

8. Monitoring and Traffic Flow

Traffic conditions must be actively monitored.

If unreasonable congestion, safety risks, or operational impacts occur, or if directed by an authorised Council officer, traffic arrangements must be modified or traffic lanes reopened immediately.

9. Clean-Up and Reinstatement

Upon completion of works:

- All traffic control devices must be removed;
- The road reserve must be left in a clean, safe and tidy condition;
- Any temporary works must be reinstated appropriately.

10. Revocation or Suspension

Council reserves the right to:

- Suspend, amend or revoke this approval at any time;
- Direct immediate cessation of works where public safety is compromised;
- Issue compliance notices where conditions are not met.

11. Notification of Works Schedule

The Applicant or Principle Contractor must provide Gympie Regional Council with a forward works schedule detailing all activities proposed to be undertaken under this blanket approval.

- The works schedule shall be submitted to Council no less than ten (10) business days prior to the commencement of works and shall include:
 - Proposed works locations
 - Description of works
 - Proposed dates and times of implementation
 - Applicable Generic Suite Traffic Guidance Scheme (TGS) number/s
 - Contact details for the responsible supervisor
- The works schedule must be submitted electronically to Gympie Regional Council's nominated Roads and Traffic Management email address AdminSupport@gympie.qld.gov.au, or via any alternative lodgement method prescribed by Council from time to time. The Applicant is responsible for ensuring the schedule has been successfully submitted and received by Council.
- Where emergency or unplanned works are required, Council must be notified as soon as reasonably practicable, and no later than the first business day following commencement of the works.
- The Applicant must provide updated schedules where programmed works are amended, postponed, cancelled, or where additional work locations are introduced.
- Submission of a works schedule does not constitute Council approval of activities that are otherwise excluded from this blanket approval or require separate assessment and approval. Activities excluded under Condition 12 must be submitted under a separate application process.
- Council reserves the right to direct modifications to the proposed timing, staging, or traffic management arrangements where network operations, public safety, major events, school activities, emergency management activities, or other operational considerations may be adversely affected.

12. Restrictions on Use of Generic Suite Traffic Guidance Schemes (TGSs)

Notwithstanding any other condition of this approval, Generic Suite Traffic Guidance Schemes (TGSs) may only be utilised where the proposed works do not result in significant impacts to traffic operations, vulnerable road users, or critical transport infrastructure.

The use of Generic Suite TGSs is expressly prohibited for the following activities, which shall require separate application and written approval from Gympie Regional Council prior to implementation:

- Works that impact the operation of traffic signals, including any activity within a signalised intersection that requires modification to traffic movements, lane arrangements, signal infrastructure, signal visibility, or signal operation.
- Works that impact the traffic flow or operational performance of a Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) controlled road or asset, including intersections, approaches, ramps, bridges, and associated road infrastructure. Such works must be referred separately for assessment and approval.
- Works located within school zones or where the works may impact school-related traffic movements, pedestrian crossings, active transport routes, or student commuting activities. Where approved, these works shall only be undertaken between 9:30am and 2:30pm on school days, unless otherwise authorised in writing by Council.
- Works on the following roads are excluded from this blanket approval and shall require separate approval from Council prior to commencement:
 - Mary Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Glendore Lane GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Reef Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Young Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Smithfield Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Nash Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Lawrence Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Monkland Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - O'Connell Street GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - Jaycee Way GYMPIE QLD 4570
 - River Road GYMPIE QLD 4570 (between Monkland Street and Gladstone Street)
 - Duke Street GYMPIE QLD 4570 (between Channon Street and Jane Street)
 - Rainbow Beach Road RAINBOW BEACH QLD 4581

13. Compliance Monitoring and Auditing

Gympie Regional Council may undertake random, scheduled, or unannounced inspections and audits of any work site operating under this blanket approval to verify compliance with the approved Traffic Guidance Scheme (TGS), the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), relevant Austroads guidance, and all conditions of this approval.

The Applicant must provide authorised Council officers with reasonable access to work sites, traffic management documentation, inspection records, risk assessments, and any other information reasonably requested for the purposes of auditing or compliance monitoring.

Where a non-compliance is identified, Council may direct the Applicant to immediately rectify the matter, implement additional traffic management measures, suspend the works, or undertake any other action considered necessary to ensure public safety and network efficiency.

Repeated or significant non-compliance with the conditions of this approval may result in the suspension, amendment, or revocation of this blanket approval at Council's discretion.

14. Council Direction for Separate Approval

Council reserves the right to direct the Applicant to obtain separate approval for any activity where, in the opinion of an authorised Council officer, the proposed traffic management arrangements may adversely affect safety, traffic efficiency, access, or the operation of the road network.

This determination may be made regardless of whether the activity would otherwise be eligible for implementation under this blanket approval, and the Applicant must not commence the activity until any required separate approval has been obtained.
