### **Blanket Conditional Approval Permit**

**For the operation of a regulated activity being interference with a road under *Local Law No 11 (Roads and Malls) 2008* and under Clause 24 of the Memorandum of Understanding between City of Gold Coast and Energex.**

Location: CITY OF GOLD COAST CONTROLLED ROADS  
**Type of closure:** TEMPORARY HALF ROAD / LANE / PARKING LANE /  
VERGE CLOSURES  
ALL FULL TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES REQUIRE A  
SEPARATE APPLICATION  
Reason for closure: ENERGEX WORKS  
Traffic controller: REGISTERED TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS  
Date of closure: 1 JULY 2021 TO 30 JUNE 2022

In accordance with Section 13 of *Local Law No. 11 (Roads and Malls) 2008* and **subject to the conditions** listed below, Council hereby grants the Applicant a permit to operate the regulated activity.

### **Conditions of Permit**

**1. Compliance with requirements of Subordinate Local Law 11.1**

Energex must comply with the requirements of section 7 of *Subordinate Local Law No.11.1 (Interference with a Road) 2008*.

**2. Queensland Police Service Permit to be obtained**

Energex must obtain a road closure permit from the Queensland Police Service (QPS) prior to commencement of the regulated activity.

**A copy of the QPS permit must be available at the site of the temporary road closure for the duration of the works.**

**3. Other City Approved Closures**

This Permit covers various locations and timeframes as such, Transport & Traffic are unable to complete an adequate conflict check with other City approved closures. In the event that a conflict occurs, works will need to be rescheduled to give priority to other City approved closures.

**4. Cessation of work if traffic delays excessive**

In the event that traffic delays are unduly excessive or disruptive, Council may withdraw this Permit and require the road to be opened.

**5. Additional City permits / approvals required**

Prior to commencement of the regulated activity, the Applicant must contact the City's Urban Precincts Coordinator on (07) 5581 1709, to obtain approval and conditions for access to malls, footpaths and foreshore areas.

**Other parties to be notified**

- a) Prior to the commencement of the regulated activity all Emergency Service authorities in the relevant area of the temporary road closure are to be notified of the temporary road closure.
- b) Local residents, businesses, bus and taxi companies directly affected are to be advised through public notices, media or letterbox notices prior to the temporary road or verge closure.
- c) Where there is a potential that the regulated activity may interfere with the operation of the light rail and in any event for all proposed works and temporary traffic management control devices within 25 metres of the light rail corridor, prior to the commencement of the regulated activity, the Applicant must consult with GoldLinQ Pty Ltd and KDR Gold Coast Pty Ltd (the 'light rail operator') and obtain the light rail operator's consent (KDR LONO) to the proposed works and ensure that such works are undertaken in accordance with requirements and reasonable directions of the light rail operator.

**Manner in which works are to be conducted**

- a) All operations must be conducted according to the requirements of *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) (Part 3) Works on Roads*; and the *Work Health & Safety Act 2011*.
- b) Traffic Controllers are to be qualified, registered and certified. Proof of accreditations must be carried on their person at all times whilst on the work site / event area for the duration of the works.
- c) Energex must restore the area to original or approved condition at completion of the works.

- d) Works on arterial roads (i.e. yellow roads in UBD) and adjacent to schools where congestion is expected, are to be conducted outside of peak traffic times, (7:00am to 9:00am and 2:30pm to 4:00pm).

**Insurance**

Energex must hold a broad form public liability insurance policy for a minimum of \$20 million or another amount specified by the City in respect of the regulated activity.

**Amendments**

The City may by written notice to Energex amend the conditions contained in this permit or incorporate additional conditions from time to time as it reasonably requires.
