CONDITIONS

- 1. QPS reserves the right to apply additional conditions, cancel, revoke or alter this approval at any time, if deemed nescessary. This application will be required to be re-applied for at expiry date.
- 2. Ensure all emergency services, namely QAS, QFES and Moreton District Police, are aware of access to available roads.
- 3. Official traffic signs "ROAD CLOSED" to be positioned at approach to the work area.
- 4. Traffic controller to direct traffic while road is closed.
- 5. Witches hats to be positioned around the work area in a delineator line so as to direct traffic into open section of roadway.
- 6. Official traffic signs, lights and safety cones shall comply with the manual of uniform traffic control devices part 3 are positioned and erected as per the Queensland Transport roadworking signing guide.
- 7. All precautions to be taken to avoid incidents.
- 8. During hours of darkness barricading to be erected around work area and operational flashing amber lights to be positioned on barricading at two meter intervals.

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- 9. All signs and other material to be removed from roadway/footpath and roadway/footpath to be left in good serviceable condition.
- 10. Applicant to ensure that all conditions stipulated by the Department of Main Roads shall be strictly adhered to, however delays to any single vehicle must not excess four (4) minutes.
- 11. Equipment and site vehicles must not impede the safe flow of traffic.
- 12. Work is not to impede the safe flow of pedestrian traffic.
- 13. Not to impede pedestrian traffic.
- 14. All works shall be carried out in accordance with relevant State Government Legislation including but not limited to the Work Health and Safety Avt 2011 and Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act 1995.
- 15. No works on public holidays permitted.
- 16. PERMIT TO BE HELD ON SITE AT ALL TIES AND PRODUCED UPON REQUEST BY A POLICE OFFICER.

This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.
