13. MINOR WORKS ON ROADS AS DEFINED IN QLD GLOBE ROAD:

CATEGORY 1 ROADS (ALL CLOSURE TYPES EXCEPT FULL ROAD CLOSURES) BETWEEN 0600 - 1800 & 1800-0600.

CATEGORY 2 ROADS:

PARKING LANE, SHOULDER, PARTIAL LANE CLOSURES BETWEEN 0600-1800 & 1800-0600. IN A SINGLE DIRECTION CONTRAFLOW/LATERAL SHIFT PROVIDED THE EXISTING TRAFFIC LANE CAPACITY IS MAINTAINED, HOLD & RELEASE CLOSURES BETWEEN 0900-1600 WEEKDAYS, 0500-2000 WEEKENDS & 2000-0500 OVERNIGHT.

- 14. CLOSURE NOT PERMITTED ON CONNECTING ROADS WITHIN THE DISTRICT DURING PEAK HOURS 7.00AM 9.00AM & 3.00PM 7.00PM
- 15. DEDICATED PARKING LANES PERMITTED TO BE CLOSED ANY TIME WHERE CURRENT LANE CAPACITY IS NOT IMPACTED
- 16. ALL CLOSURES WITHIN SCHOOL ZONES RESTRICTED 9.00AM 2.00PM
- 17. ON SCHOOL DAYS. WHERE STOP/HOLD & RELEASE IN PLACE SUCH CLOSURE TO BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM WITH REOPENING OF THROUGH TRAFFIC AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE BUT NO MORE THAN TWO MINUTES; STOP/HOLD IS NOT TO CAUSE TRAFFIC CONGESTION AND IS TO BE TIMED TO MINIMISE TRAFFIC BUILDUP.
- 18. WITH SCHOOL SPEED RESTRICTED ZONES DURING THE IMPLEMENTATION TIMES, WITHIN 1KM RADIUS OF RNA SHOWGROUNDS DURING EVENTS & ON EVENT DAYS/NIGHTS SUNCORP TRAFFIC AREA. NO CLOSURES PERMITTED DURING PLANNED MAJOR EVENTS. NO CLOSURES PERMITTED BRISBANE CBD & FORTITUDE VALLEY AREAS.
- 19. NO CLOSURES IN SUNCORP TRAFFIC AREA OR WITHIN 1KM RADIUS OF RNA SHOWGROUNDS DURING EVENTS
- 20. APPLICANT SHALL IMMEDIATELY OBEY ANY LAWFUL DIRECTION GIVEN BY POLICE.
- 21. PERMIT NOT VALID WHERE OTHER ROAD/LANE CLOSURE APPROVALS HAVE BEEN GRANTED AND IS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH OTHER WORKS IN PLACE.
- 22. PERMIT NOT VALID IN DISABLED PARKING ZONES, CLEARWAYS, BUS STOPS, ACCESS TO PROPERTIES, WORKS I/V SCHOOL ZONES
- 23. TWO WAY TRAFFIC TO BE MAINTAINED WHERE POSSIBLE.
- 24. SEPARATE PERMIT TO BE OBTAINED WORKS BEING PERFORMED AT TRAFFIC CONTROL LIGHTS WHERE THERE IS INTERFERENCE WITH SIGNALS OR NEED FOR POLICE TRAFFIC CONTROL.
- 25. WHERE ACCREDITED TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS DO NOT HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO PERFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL SEPERATE POLICE PERMIT MUST BE OBTAINED.
- 26. ROAD TO BE LEFT IN SERVICEABLE CONDITION FREE OF ANY OBSTRUCTIONS AFTER WORKS.
