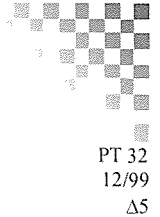

TEMPORARY HALF ROAD/LANE/PARKING LANE/VERGE CLOSURES of various council controlled roads within Gold Coast District for the purpose of conducting installation and/or maintenance works.

Permit shall remain in force from 01/07/2021 to 30/06/2022, unless sooner suspended, surrendered or cancelled.

CONDITIONS

1. This permit is to be held on site at all times and produced on demand to a Police Officer.
2. All signs, lights and safety cones to comply with and to be positioned and erected as per the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
3. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that any excavations, roadworks, barriers, signs, materials or objects of any nature associated with the project development are sufficiently lit or made obvious to any pedestrians or motorists so as to prevent risk of injury or death to any person.
4. Safety cones and/or barricading is to be positioned around work areas.
5. Pedestrian access is to be restricted from work sites at all times.
6. During the hours of darkness, barricading shall be positioned around work areas with sufficient flashing amber lights at regular intervals to give adequate warning to pedestrian and vehicular traffic to prevent collision with barricading or excavation materials or trenches.
7. All signs and materials to be removed from roadway and left in good condition at the completion of works.
8. All Council and/or Mains Road Department conditions to be complied with.
9. Alternative safe passage to be made for pedestrians and motorists.
10. Entry and egress are to be maintained for residential and business premises AT ALL TIMES.
11. Minimum of One (1) Qualified Traffic Controller and One (1) Traffic Control Vehicle to be on duty during the hours of each site operation to assist motorists and pedestrians around work site as required.
12. All care to be taken to avoid incidents.
13. Access to be available to emergency vehicles at all times.
14. This authority applies to MINOR WORKS ONLY; white roads in the UBD only and no yellow or coloured roads in the UBD are permitted to be closed under this permit.

This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.
