This permit is issued for Lane/Shoulder/Parking Lane Closures, for the purpose of electrical maintenance and low impact works on behalf of Energex at various locations (UBD white and yellow roads only) within local government areas constituted as Moreton Bay Regional Council permit (A15303893) area located within the Queensland Police Service Moreton District.

Permit shall remain in force from 30/06/2018 to 30/06/2019, unless sooner suspended, surrendered or cancelled.

CONDITIONS


1. QPS reserves the right to apply additional conditions, cancel, revoke or alter this approval at any time, if deemed necessary. This application will be required to be re-applied for at expiry date.
2. All signs, lights and safety cones shall comply with and be positioned/erected in accordance with the manual for uniform traffic control devices part 3.
3. Accredited traffic controllers shall operate in accordance with the traffic controller accreditation scheme approved procedure.
4. Access to and from business/residential premises is to be maintained at all times unless prior arrangements with the occupier.
5. All precautions to be taken to avoid incidents.
6. Area to be defined to prevent pedestrian access through workforce.
7. Permit is for minor works on white and yellow roads as defined in the UBD street directory only. No closures permitted at tnr controlled roads. No full road closures or excavations on roadway permitted.
8. Applicant shall immediately obey any lawful direction given by police.
9. Permit not valid in bus stops/zones, disabled parking zones, taxi zones, clearways, within 20m of a signalised intersection, works in schools zones with school speed restricted zones during the implementation times.
10. Closures within 100m of school zones on school days restricted to between 9:00am and 2:00pm only.
11. Where traffic of pedestrian control is required, accredited traffic controllers to be on site to perform that function.
12. Permit not valid where other road/lane closure approvals have been granted and is not to interfere with other works in place.

13. Where accredited traffic controllers do not have the authority to perform traffic control a separate police permit must be obtained.
14. Road to be left in serviceable condition free of any obstructions after works.
15. Closure not permitted on connecting roads within the region during peak hours 7:00am to 9:00am and 3:00pm to 7:00pm.
16. Separate permit to be obtained for works being performed at traffic control lights where they interfere with signals or need for police traffic control.
17. A safe route to be provided for pedestrians.
18. **PERMIT TO BE HELD ON SITE AT ALL TIMES AND PRODUCED UPON REQUEST BY A POLICE OFFICER.**

This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.
