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

Whose signature appears hereon, is hereby permitted, subject to the conditions, if any, specified hereunder to conduct the following temporary, full/partial road/closure shoulder/footpath road/closure/s and implement Department of transport and Main Roads(DTMR) approved Traffic Management Plan (TMP) and Toowoomba Regional Council (TRC) non-objection to conduct Regulated Activity within Lockyer Valley Regional Council areas on behalf of any company that engages Altus Traffic.


Roads Closed Lockyer Valley Regional Council area.
Dates: Sunday 1 July 2018 to Sunday 30 July 2019
Between the hours of 24 hours – 6am to 6am

CONDITIONS

1. This permit is to be held on site at all times and produced on request of a Police Officer; any and all police directions are to be obeyed;
2. Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act and Regulations are to be complied with;
3. All signs, lights and safety cones to comply with and to be positioned and erected as per the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices* and all signs and material to be removed from roadway and roadway left in good condition at completion of Works;
4. The applicant is responsible to ensure that any barriers, signs, materials or objects of any nature associated with the Site Works comply with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices and during the hours of darkness, barricading shall be positioned around the road closure with sufficient flashing amber lights at regular intervals to give adequate warning to pedestrian and vehicular traffic to prevent collision with barricading ; Full Barricading shall be erected at all road closure points;
5. All works are subject to the approval from the applicable road authority ie: Department of Transport and Main Roads, Environmental Protection Agency and Lockyer Valley Regional Council (LVRC) prior to the commencement of works unless urgent reason applies;
6. Work can be performed between the hours of 06.00am to 06.00am daily subject to approval and conditions from LVRC and/or Department of Main Roads (DTMR). No work is to be carried out on public holidays without consent of TRC and/or DTMR unless it is Emergency works;



8. In the event of a road closure to through traffic, advice to media outlets for information to the public to be provided;
9. All care to be taken to avoid incidents. Upon cessation, all litter shall be removed and the road returned to its original condition];
10. Business / residents within the closed roads shall be given ingress and egress to and from their premises at all times unless urgent reason applies;
11. Emergency Services Queensland are to be notified of changed traffic conditions; emergency vehicle access to be maintained at all times;
12. This permit shall remain in force for the below period unless sooner suspended, surrendered or cancelled;
13. *The Queensland Police Service will not be responsible for any public litigation that may result from any incidents associated with the accuracy and implementation of the traffic guidance schemes under this permit. The Applicant in signing this notice, accepts all responsibility for any public litigation associated with all Traffic Guidance Schemes & should take appropriate measures to insure they have sufficient legal cover & public liability insurance;*
