whose signature appears hereon, is hereby permitted, subject to the conditions hereunder to:

- 1. To position plant (Elevating Work Platforms, Lift/Borers/work vehicles) on roadways facing oncoming traffic in circumstances where identified site hazards increase the operational risk to personnel and or plant.
- 2. For Energy Queensland Limited ACN 612 535 583 and its subsidiary companies Ergon Energy Corporation Limited ACN 087 646 062, Energex Limited 078 849 055, employees of these companies, and authorised contractors of these companies.
- 3. To perform maintenance and consturction activities on Energy Queensland Limited, Ergon Energy Coporation Limited and Energex Limited assets and associated infructure.
- 4. This permit is valid for all roads within the State of Queensland.

Permit shall remain in force from	01/01/2024	to	31/12/2024	, unless sooner
suspended, surrendered or cancelled.				

CONDITIONS

- 1. Permit shall be carried by driver at all times (electronic copy sufficient).
- 2. The work site shall be configured according to the relevant requirements within Energy Queensland Working on Roadways Manual or conducted in accordance with the Queensland Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and Australian Standard AS1742.3.
- 3. All care is to be taken to avoid incidents with other road users.
- 4. Operators must hold a current Driver's Licence and/or Operators Certificate for class of vehicle and requirement of work to be undertaken.
- 5. This permit does not exclude the holder from obtaining any other necessary permission or authority from the relevant government departments or authorities prior to work commencing.
- 6. Vehicles to be covered by appropriate Public Liability Insurance.
- 7. Transport Operations (Road Use Management) Act and Regulations must be complied with at all times.
- 8. Flashing amber lights and warning signs (where applicable) to be fixed to vehicles.
- 9. Sufficient warning signs and barricades erected whilst equipment is operating on roads/footpaths.
- 10. Completion of road closures for short term work/traffic control must be completed in line with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) requirements.

This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.
