
At All roads within the Logan City Council boundaries

CONDITIONS

1. This permit is to be held on site at all times and produced on demand to a Police Officer.
2. All signs, lights and safety cones to comply with the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*.
3. Signage to be positioned and erected as per the *Transport Department Roadwork's Signing Guide*.
4. The applicant is responsible to ensure that any excavations, roadwork's, barriers, signs, materials or objects of any nature associated with the project development are sufficiently light or made obvious to any pedestrian or motorist so as to prevent risk of injury or death to any person.
5. Safety cones or barricading is to be positioned around work area.
6. Pedestrian access is to be restricted from work site at all times.
7. During the hours of darkness, barricading shall be positioned around work area with sufficient flashing amber lights at regular intervals to give adequate warning to pedestrian and vehicular traffic to prevent collision with barricading or excavation materials or trenches.
8. All signs and material to be removed from roadway and roadway left in good condition at completion of work.
9. Logan City Council conditions to be complied with **RC/990/2025**.
10. Alternative safe passage to be made available for pedestrians.
11. QPS to be complied if traffic light is switched off and/ or flashing amber.
12. **All care to be taken to avoid incidents.**
