Other Requirements and Information

An 'electric line' is defined under section 15(1) of the Electricity Act 1994 as 'a wire or conductor or associated equipment used for transmitting, transforming, or supplying electricity at a voltage greater than extra low voltage'.

Under section 24 of the Electricity Regulation 2006 you are required to consult with the following entities before installing and operating a low voltage electric line:

- the relevant supplier (completion and submission of this form to ENERGEX for approval will discharge this obligation);
if the proposed location for the low voltage electric line is a publicly controlled place – the local government or other entity with responsibility for the place; and
if the proposed location for the low voltage electric line is a place other than a publicly controlled place – the owner and each lessee or occupier of the place.

You may not proceed with the installation and operation of the proposed low voltage electric line unless you have a written response from ENERGEX to this application stating that ENERGEX has no objection to the installation and operation of the electric line.

You must ensure that the installation and operation of the proposed low voltage electric line is not likely to cause a fire or a person to suffer an electric shock. Additionally, the proposed low voltage electric line must be installed in accordance with AS/NZS3000 - The Wiring Rules and any requirements or conditions imposed by any entity.

If you install the proposed low voltage electric line without meeting all of the above-listed requirements, you may be directed to remove the electric line at your expense by a regulator. If you do not follow this type of direction given by a regulator, a regulator may remove the electric line and recover the cost of the removal from you as a debt payable to the State.

Non-compliance with any of these requirements will constitute in a breach of the Electricity Regulation and may result in enforcement action.
