regulate (or cause to be regulated) traffic including the implementation of stop and hold protocols as required to facilitate minor works and maintenance activities in the Noosa Local Council Area.

Permit shall remain in force from 01/07/2024 to 30/06/2025, unless sooner suspended, surrendered or cancelled.

CONDITIONS

1. On condition of obtaining the relevant Road Reserve Maintenance Activities Approval from the Noosa Local Council and this is to be considered the primary operational document.
2. Adhere to all conditions stipulated in any permit, approvals or authorisations issued by the Noosa Local Council.
3. Accredited Traffic Controllers are to be engaged to undertake any regulation of traffic.
4. Traffic control, during construction and or maintenance is to be provided and maintained in accordance with the current Queensland Department of Transport and Main Roads 'Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices' Part 3. The traffic management plan must confirm to the MUTCD and be signed off by an officer who has completed MUTCD Level 3 qualification. The name and qualification of the completing officer must be shown on the plan. Approved traffic management plans are to be provided to and retained by the applicant's site manager and/or staff.
5. Permits and approvals for pedestrian access relating to footpaths and walkways will be through the local authority.
6. There is to be minimal disruption to vehicular and/or pedestrian traffic.
7. The permit cannot be altered or transferred.
8. The permit is to be carried and made available upon request by an authorised officer.
9. The permit may be varied or revoked at any time by a Police Officer acting in the public safety and welfare.
10. Permit has been applied for by Altus Traffic on behalf of Energex. Permit has been issued to Energex and are the responsible for the provisions of the permit. The applicant, Altus Traffic, has made application for this permit and are not responsible for the provisions of this permit.

This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.
