2. Works are to be carried out between the times stated above.
3. A separate Road Corridor Use permit is to be obtained from Council when a Full Road Closure and detour are to be implemented.
4. The management of all traffic through the work location (including pedestrians/cyclists) must comply with Queensland MUTCD, relevant Australian Standards, and QGTTM and the relevant Austroads Guides. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in the immediate issue of an order to cease work within the road reserve. In accordance with the Department of Transport & Main Roads (TMR) Traffic Management Registration Scheme, regulatory signage/traffic control may only be implemented by a traffic management company registered with TMR. 8. The applicant by accepting the above conditions, hereby indemnifies the Council against any claim, action or process for damage of injury which might from the work being carried out

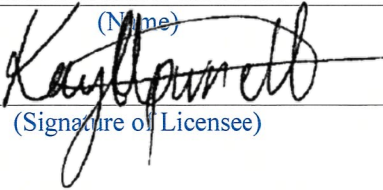

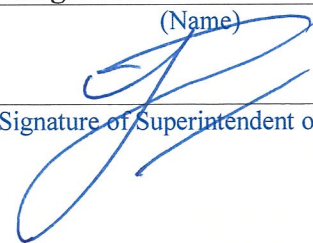
