**TEMPORARY PARTIAL AND FULL ROAD CLOSURES – ENERGEX WORKS IN LOGAN CITY  
PERMIT NO: TP9057**

---

Thank you for your application received 23 May 2018 requesting Logan City Council's approval to undertake temporary partial and full road closures on roads controlled by Logan City Council for the purpose of general maintenance works on behalf of EnergeX.

Logan City Council has no objection to the partial or full road closures on Council controlled roads by EnergeX (or EnergeX contractors) providing the following conditions are met:-

1. The closures are permitted on 1 July 2018 until 30 June 2019 (approximately 1 day each time, only as necessary).
2. Works may be undertaken on major roads (60km/h or greater) between 9.00am and 4.00pm weekdays, between 5.00am and 8.00pm Saturday and Sundays, and between 8.00pm and 5.00am overnight.
3. Works within a School Zone only permitted outside of school zone times.
4. Works permitted 24 hours on other local roads (50km/h or less) except where works impact on major roads during peak periods.
5. Full road closures are only permitted on local roads (50km/h or less) outside of School Zones between 6.00am and 6.00pm.
6. Detours associated with full road closures are to be logical and add no more than 2 minutes travel time (in normal driving conditions). Detour signs are to be monitored and adjusted as required to avoid driver confusion. Time restrictions indicated in Conditions 2 and 3 apply for any detours along major roads or local roads with School Zones.
7. Contraflow conditions are acceptable where there is insufficient kerbside space to maintain regular traffic lanes, and where current lane capacity is maintained.

8. Where applicable, two way traffic is to be maintained at all times on major (60km/h or greater) roads. If necessary, hold and release is permitted for maximum of two (2) minutes and to be timed with any nearby traffic signals where possible. Stop/slow closures are allowed on local (50km/h or less) roads only if necessary and where there is no direct impact on capacity of nearby major (60km/h or greater) roads.
9. A separate application must be submitted for works outside the above conditions, major projects (non-maintenance works exceeding one shift), and for works at or near signalised intersections which may impact on traffic signal operations.
10. Roadwork signage and traffic management must be in place for each work site and in general accordance with your Traffic Guidance Schemes (received by Council on 24 May 2018) and the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices "MUTCD" temporary road closure specifications. End road work speed limit signage is to be consistent with the prevailing speed limit of the road. Traffic Services site personnel are to ensure disruption to traffic in the area is minimised. Access to driveways is to be maintained at all times.
11. If existing pedestrian access cannot be maintained, appropriate alternative provisions and signage must be erected. Any pedestrian detours are to be logical, legible and of reasonable distance for the likely users (taking into consideration proximity to schools, etc).
12. Traffic controllers are to be appointed and operate in accordance with MUTCD and Transport and Main Roads Traffic Controller Accreditation Scheme (Approved Procedure). Police are to control any traffic signals requiring a traffic controller. South Coast Traffic Management Centre (07 5561 3800) must be contacted when Police turn traffic signals off (or to flash) and also when turning signals back on.
13. Logan City Council to be notified of works requiring full road closure with actual closure date (and associated TGS), at least two (2) business days prior to works commencing. Any affected residents and businesses are to be consulted prior to works commencing.
14. Obtain Police Road Closure Permit.
15. Notify Queensland Police Services, local Ambulance and Fire Services prior to the closure.
16. TransLink and bus operators must be notified of any works impacting bus routes or bus stops. TransLink (ph: 0476 821 080) requires at least 21 days notice prior to commencement of works. Notification can be undertaken by completing Translink's online form at: <https://forms.business.gov.au/aba/landing.htm?formCode=SID-TCA>

17. Check and coordinate (as required) to avoid conflict with other roadworks and associated traffic management occurring in the area. A list of roads and drainage works planned in Logan for coming months can be found on Council's website under Planning and Building (Maintenance and Works).
18. This permit does not give priority over work areas. Due to the various locations associated with this permit, Energex may find the above areas are already occupied by another approved works. If this is the case, the applicant is not to occupy any of these areas without the express consent from the onsite Supervisor.

19. Logan City Council does not accept any responsibility for damage to or repair work resulting from the activities carried out by the approved applicant or a person on behalf of the approved applicant.
  20. Following completion of the works, the road is to be left in a condition similar to that prior to closure.
  21. The permit does not incur a fee as it is an amendment of TP8917 (originally issued to Altus Traffic).
  22. Permits will only be extended or amended once free of charge (where there is 7 working days notice), any further extensions or amendments will incur a fee of \$166.00.
  23. Logan City Council has issued this permit on the basis of the most recent information formally submitted with the current application. However, the decision to issue a permit is NOT an endorsement or approval of the safety or effectiveness of the Traffic Control Plan (TCP) and does NOT imply that the TCP complies with all applicable laws, regulations, by-laws, codes, standards, guidelines or manuals. Council disclaims any responsibility or liability that may arise from or in connection with the TCP submitted by the applicant.
