whose signature appears hereon, is hereby permitted, subject to the conditions hereunder to:

Provide traffic control on behalf of Energex at various locations throughout the Sunshine Coast Regional Council boundaries for the purpose of short term low impact works. Permission for partial road closure only, lane, shoulder, parking, footpath and/or verge with stop/slow, lateral shift, hold and release as required.

Permit shall remain in force from 10/07/2026 to 30/06/2027, unless sooner suspended, surrendered or cancelled.

CONDITIONS

1. The holder of this permit may operate under the conditions of this permit between 0000hrs and 0000hrs on the nominated dates 10/07/2026 to 30/06/2026, unless otherwise approved in writing by the issuing authority.
2. All Traffic Guidance Schemes (TGS), Traffic Management Plans (TMP) and traffic control devices must comply with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) Part 3 and the Queensland/Austrroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management (QGTMM/AGTTM).
3. All traffic control signage and works must be consistent with the approved Traffic Management Plan and TGS # 2024-ALT-GENERIC-207 dated 14/06/2026; TGS # 2024-ALT-GENERIC-103 dated 14/06/2026; TGS # 24-QLD-GEN440 dated 14/06/2026; TGS # 2024-ALT-GENERIC-223 dated 14/06/2024; TGS # 2024-ALT-GENERIC-135 dated 14/06/2026; TGS # 2024-ALT-GENERIC-435 dated 14/06/2026; and TGS # 2024-ALT-GENERIC-099 dated 14/06/2026 submitted with the application. Signage must remain in place for the duration of the works.
4. All traffic control signage must be installed, operated and maintained in accordance with these standards.
5. Accredited traffic controllers, together with appropriate vehicles and equipment must be present on site to manage traffic and pedestrian movements in accordance with the approved TGS and TMP.
6. Traffic controllers must operate in full compliance with the Traffic Controller Accreditation Scheme (TCAS).
7. The permit may be cancelled or the conditions altered by a police officer if required for the safe and effective regulation of traffic or for the safety of the public or participants.
8. A copy of this permit and all associated approvals must be kept on site for the duration of the works and produced immediately upon request by an authorised authority.

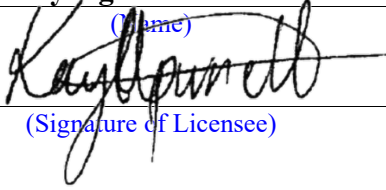
This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.

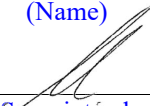
