The Queensland Police Service has no objection to the provision of a temporary partial road closure approval for road closures that relate to Energex maintenance activities. This General Permit does not give approval for the works associated with the temporary road closure.

Permit shall remain in force from 01/07/2018 to 30/06/2019, unless sooner suspended, surrendered or cancelled.

### CONDITIONS

1. All works are to be carried out in accordance with the times stated above.
2. All works are to be carried out in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) Part 3 Works on Roads.
3. A traffic management plan must be prepared in accordance with the Transport and Main Roads Traffic Management Registration Scheme by a traffic management company registered with TMR
4. A copy of this permit must be kept onsite and produced if requested.
5. This approval applies only to Energex sub-contractors for the purpose of conducting maintenance works.
6. Any traffic disruption is to be kept to a minimum; access to driveways is to be maintained.
7. Pedestrian access is to be maintained at all times or an alternative pedestrian access provided.
8. The Queensland Police Service reserves the right to review and cancel this permit and/or reissue with amended conditions as deemed necessary.
9. The conditions in the Sunshine Coast Council approval issued 11/06/18 1-17 to be complied with.

This permit does not exempt the holder thereof from obtaining any Permit or other authority under and/or otherwise complying with the provisions of any other law.
