- 2. All works are to be carried out in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) Part 3 Works on Roads.
- 3. A traffic management plan must be prepared in accordance with the Transport and Main Roads Traffic Management Registration Scheme by a traffic management company registered with TMR
- 4. A copy of this permit must be kept onsite and produced if requested.
- 5. This approval applies only to Energex sub-contractors for the purpose of conducting maintenance works.
- 6. Any traffic disruption is to be kept to a minimum; access to driveways is to be maintained.
- 7. Pedestrian access is to be maintained at all times or an alternative pedestrian access provided.
- 8. The Queensland Police Service reserves the right to review and cancel this permit and/or reissue with amended conditions as deemed necessary.
- 9. The conditions in the Sunshine Coast Council approval issued 11/06/18 1-17 to be complied with.
