

What is PeakSmart?

PeakSmart air conditioners are offered by most of the leading brands on the market today. It's the most advanced technology in air-conditioning and it helps us to manage peak demand and run our electricity network more efficiently.

How does it work?

A signal receiver has been installed in the PeakSmart air-conditioner. This allows us to send a signal remotely via the power supply to your air conditioner to cap its energy consumption on occasions when the network reaches peak demand. We call this a 'PeakSmart event'. This only happens a few times a year.

Will I notice a difference?

No. The effect is similar to your air conditioner being in economy mode and you won't notice a difference to your comfort.

How do I know when a PeakSmart event has been called?

Some PeakSmart air conditioners have a Demand Response Mode (DRM) display on the indoor unit. The display could be labelled DRM1, DRM2, or DRM3, but wording may differ between models. Some models do not have a display mode. Please check your air conditioning manual as each model may differ.

Does this affect my air conditioner's warranty?

No. Your existing manufacturer warranty has not been affected
